2. Follow up discussion to Synod

- a. The discussion during the February 3 special meeting of the Pastoral Council and subsequent survey generated a set of 14 themes. Of these themes, the themes that were ranked the highest priority by the Council were engaging with the younger generation, allowing priests to marry/allowing deacons to celebrate Mass (addressing the shortage of priests), and communication between the Catholic Church and its parishioners.
- b. The Council will meet again on March 3, 2022 to discuss these themes in greater detail and discuss our final report to submit to the Diocese.
